- WHEREAS, In November, the Employment Assistance Office experienced a \$25,764.00 budget cut for Fiscal Year 1977 services, (From 102,000.00 Fiscal Year 1976 to \$76,236.00 Fiscal Year 1977)
- WHEREAS, Present funding is not adequate to meet Oneida's needs for Fiscal Year 1977 DE services and AVT students; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- A. The Oneida Tribe of Indians requests additional funding through any sources available to include:
1. Year-end leftover monies.
  2. New legislation passed to develop additional funding.
  3. Emergency or any other form of funding.
