RESOLUTION # 1-8-92-13

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Nation is to protect, maintain, and improve the standard of living and the environment in which the Oneida people live; while maintaining and re-establishing the sovereign rights of the Oneida Nation, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has determined to be a priority, the creation of housing to meet the needs of tribal members, and
- WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin, through the Department of Administration has made funds available for the purpose of assisting and developing the capacity to provide or expand housing activities benefiting lower income households.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, authorizes and submits this grant application to the Wisconsin Department of Administration, Division of Housing, for the purpose of obtaining funds that will enable the Oneida Tribe to develop and expand its capacity to provide housing opportunities that will benefit low-income families on the Oneida Reservation.
