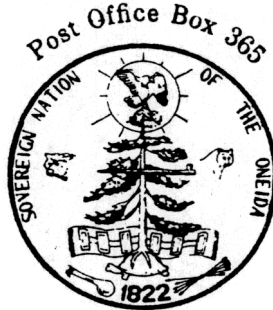




Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

RESOLUTION NO. 1-12-83-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is concerned with providing adequate administrative support for all Tribal programs, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has negotiated and Indirect Cost Rate in accordance with OMB regulations and approved by Office of Inspector General,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests a contract from the Bureau of Indians Affairs in compliance with the Indirect Cost Agreement for administrative support funding for all Bureau of Indian Affairs programs negotiated with the Tribe.
