A parcel of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, T. 23N R18E, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wis., described as follows to wit: Beginning at the NE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, T. 23, R18; thence West 40 rods; thence South 20 rods; thence East 40 rods; thence North on the Section line to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres of land, more or less and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has agreed to received the land for payment of existing mortgage in the amount of less than \$600.00 on the above described property, and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has funds to acquire this property, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this land is to consolidate tribal ownership of land.
