

RESOLUTION NO. 1-20-93-E

WHEREAS, Wanita J. DeCorah, a tribal member, and Rhea J. DeCorah, a non-member
of W1195 Ranch Road, Oneida, Wisconsin 54155
have made application to this Committee for a long-term lease
for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, The tribal land selected is described as follows:

A parcel of land located within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 18, T. 23N.,
R. 19E., 4th P.M., Outagamie County, WI, known as Flying Leaf
Subdivision, more particularly described as:


Lot 1 Block 3 - Beginning at the NW corner of the NE fr. $\frac{1}{4}$
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of above mentioned Section; thence South a distance of
412.5 feet; thence East, a distance of 264 feet; thence North,
a distance of 412.5 feet; thence West, a distance of 264 feet,
to the Point of Beginning, containing 2.5 acres, more or less,
subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Committee in Regular session
assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency,
to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955
(69 Stat. 539), as amended, 25 USC 415, for the above-described land
with a 25-year term which shall automatically and without notice renew
for an additional term of 25 years at a ~~total~~ rental ~~of~~ at $\frac{1}{2}$ FMV
rent to be determined by land appraisal ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida
Business Committee are authorized to execute the lease on behalf of
the Oneida Tribe.
