RESOLUTION 1-27-81B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act is intended to facilitate increased self-determination for American Indians by providing a means through which they may plan, conduct and administer programs and services to Indian people, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act obligates the Bureau to assist in replanning or redesigning programs to better respond to tribal government needs, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee and the Education Board support the organizational design which provides greater coordination and accountability within all Education programs,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee makes application for \$15,990 of Indian Education funds in order to develop an administrative office for all Tribal Education programs, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chairman of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
