RESOLUTION # 2-1-91-A

- WHEREAS: the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the general goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain, and improve the standard of living, and the environment in which the Oneida people live, while maintaining and enforcing their sovereign rights, and
- WHEREAS, a Construction Committee shall be appointed to provide quality, cost effective construction while protecting the health, safety and welfare of the Oneida Tribe, the employees of the Tribe, and the community at large by establishing minimum standards that exceed State Standards for the design, construction,, structural strength, quality of materials, adequate egress facilities, sanitary facilities, natural lighting, heating, and ventilation, energy conservation, and fire safety for buildings, dwellings, mechanical systems, electrical systems, and plumbing systems.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee formally adopts the Construction Committee composed of the following departments:


