RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, 48 Oneida students from Housing Site 2 attend classes at the Seymour School District, and

WHEREAS, said students vary in ages from 5 years through 18 years, and

WHEREAS, under the busing procedure, all 48 students must wait at one pick-up on a heavily trafficked town road, and

WHEREAS, children, while waiting, play on or near the town road, and

WHEREAS, there is a hill where the bus stops and drivers of cars coming from the opposite direction cannot see the bus, and

WHEREAS, the town road is often slippery at the pick-up point, and

WHEREAS, extreme coldness during winter months causes undue discomfort to all children, particularly to the very young children, and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Motor Vehicle Division Administrative Code 17.10(7) Loading and Unloading Procedures, states that "Loading station or points must be selected with due regard for traffic and pedestrian safety, and shall be approved by school authorities",

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Oneida Education Committee requests that the bus servicing the students at Oneida Housing Site 2 be rerouted through the Site for maximum pedestrian and physical safety to such students.

CERTIFICATION
