RESOLUTION NO. # 2-4-80A

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin Electric Power Company, a Wisconsin Corporation whose business address is 807 S. Oneida Street, Appleton, Wisconsin, is to make an application for a service line agreement to the Superintendent Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Ashland, Wisconsin, for the purpose of installing street lights on the following described lands of the Oneida Indian Reservation in Outagamie County, Wisconsin:

Said street lights to be located in Sand Hill Estates Subdivision, Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, NE X 1/4 of Section nineteen (19), Township twenty-three North (T-23-N), Range nineteen East (R-19-E), Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, and,

Said street lights to be located in Hillside Homes Subdivision, that part of Government claims twenty-two (22) and twenty-three (23) in Section thirty (30), Township twenty-three North (T-23-N), Range nineteen East (R-19-E), Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The applicant desires to place such street lights for the purpose of providing lighting for added security and safety in the Oneida Housing Sites and,

WHEREAS, The installation and placing of such street lights will be made in compliance with the applicable regulation in the Code of Federal Regulations and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to waive payment of damages under the Code of Federal Regulations and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee on behalf of said Tribe, hereby grants to the applicant the service line agreement request, the location which is more particularly shown on the attached sketch maps as Exhibit "A", and that the Oneida Business Committee authorize the Chairman and/or

Secretary of the said Business Committee to sign such documents as may be required in connection with granting the service line agreement with Wisconsin Electric Power Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee request the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Ashland, Wisconsin to approve said service line agreement in accordance with the Act of February 5, 1948 (62 Stat. 17) (25 U.S.C. 323) (22 FR 248), pursuant to U.S. Title 25 CFR 161; Right-of-Way.
