

RESOLTUION 02-07-72

Resolution requesting the assistance of the U.S. Public Health Service in constructing water and sanitation facilities for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to sign and enter into agreements with the U.S. Public Health Service on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians.

Whereas, water and sanitation facilities are needed to serve each of the existing individual Indian houses programmed for renovation of tribal land on the Oneida Indian reservation and,

Whereas, the U.S. Public Health Services has asked that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin authorize one member of the Tribal Council to sign and enter into agreements with the U.S. Public Health Service on behalf of the Tribal Council,

RESOLVED by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin that the Chairman of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Business Committee is here-by given the authority to sign and enter into any and all agreements with the U.S. Public Health Service on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin which concern the construction of water and sanitation facilities to serve existing individual houses programmed for renovation with the Oneida Indian Community, and be it further

RESOLVED by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Business Committee that the U.S. Public Health Service is hereby requested to assist in the construction of the water and sanitation facilities needed to serve each of the existing individual houses programmed for renovation of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
