RESOLUTION NO. 2-19-79-6

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis., Inc. has never participated or approved in any action that would change the budget or funding process and,

WHEREAS, the site location budget process indicated a de-emphasis on the mission of the ITAC office in Denver and a dilution/dispersement of the total Indian Action Program and,

WHEREAS, Oneida will oppose and reject any attempt to weaken or diminish any of it's programs: Funding, administration, and operation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the site location budget process be rescinded and funding allocations for the Indian Action Program be established at ITAC without recourse to other Oneida programs.

CERTIFICATION
