- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin are the duly recognized governing body of the Wisconsin Oneidas, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority to carry out the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, and
- WHEREAS, the Uneida General Tribal Council at a duly called and noticed meeting held January 28, 1978 resolved to suspend Marvin Chapman as the attorney of record in Docket 301 now pending in the Indian Claims Commission and the U.S. Court of Claims because of a conflict of interest, and
- WHEREAS, that resolution also asked a report from Leo Krulitz Solicotor General of the U.S. Department of Interior on the conflict of interest of our Claims attorney, Mr. Chapman, and
- WHEREAS, the suspension was not recognized by the U.S. Court of Claims February 6, 1978 and oral argumentywas permitted, and
- WHEREAS, not having qualified counsel to appraise the Wisconsin Oneidas of our legal situation with regard to Docket 301, and
- WHEREAS, the lack of counsel is detrimental to the Oneidas of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the report requested of Mr. Krulitz would greatly assist the Oneidas in determining whether to reinstate or replace Mr. Chapman.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin demand the U.S. Department of Interior implement its trust duty to the Oneidas by reporting to the Oneida Business Committee its findings on any and all conflicts of interest on the part of Marvin Chapman existing now, since or before the commensement of the action known as Docket 301.
