Amended RESOLUTION # 03-04-98-F Lisa Smith-Behringer Resolution

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Lisa Smith-Behringer, #2411, a/are Tribal Member(s), have made application for a long-term lease for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Smith-Behringer, #2411, has/have been designated Lease No. RL-2842(97) for the Tribal land selected and is more particularly described as follows: 880 Silver Creek, Oneida WI 54155.

Part of Lot 1, Section 2, T23N-R19E, town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 2, T23N-R19E; thence S88 degrees, 39'54"W, 482.65 feet along the north line of Lot 1, said Section 2, to the point of beginning; thence S1 degree 18'08"E, 289.43 feet to the north right-of-way of Silver Creek Drive; thence S88 degrees 42'46"W, 187.66 feet along said north right-of-way; thence N2 degrees 46'08"W, 55.66 feet along the east line of Jacket 14306, Image 11, Brown County Records; thence N5 degrees 37'53"W, 100.12 feet along said east line; thence N2 degrees 46'08"W, 133.82 feet along said east line; thence N88 degrees 39'54"E, 200.06 feet along the North line of Lot 1, Section 2, T23N-R19E, to the point of beginning.

Parcel contains 56,288 square feet/1.29 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin's Division of Land Management is responsible for managing all tribal real property assets, including leases, through rules and policies approved in Oneida Real Property Law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Committee in Regular assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat, 539), as amended, 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25 year term which shall automatically and without notice renew for an additional term of 25 years at a total rental, \$1.00 per year or \$50 for fifty years, at a total rental to be determined by an appraisal, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Christine M. Doxtator, Land Management Director, or her designee, be authorized to execute said lease agreement on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
