NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs funds for technical assistance monies in the amount of _____ for auditing all above cited programs and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to sign any contracts and/or grants.
