RESOLUTION NO. VI-8002-4

DATE ENACTED March 18, 1980

Whereas, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is the duly constituted governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., and

Whereas, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Oneida Tribe, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

Whereas, by virtue of their status as a Federally recognized Indian Tribe, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby authorizes the Oneida Reservation Commission on Aging to apply for a Title VI "Direct Tribal Funding" grant, P.L. 95-478 under the new Older Americans Act, which received the Presidents signature October 18, 1978.

Whereas, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee deems it essential to the health, security and general welfare of the Oneida Tribe's Elderly that the Oneida Reservation Commission on Aging, who has demonstrated its ability to deliver social and nutrition serves, be fully authorized to submit an application for a Title VI grant.

Whereas, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee wishes to clarify all of the ramifications and benefits of the new Older Americans Act as signed by President Carter, October 18, 1978, numbered P.L. 95-478.

NOW, Therefore, be it resolved, that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee does hereby support and authorize that P.L. 95-478, Title VI grant be the responsibility of the Oneida Reservation Commission on Aging, and who shall follow the Oneida Tribal Program Policies.

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee, hereby certify that the Oneida Business Committee is composed of 9 members of whom 9 members, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting duly called, noticed and held on the 17th day of March, 1980, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such a meeting by a vote of 8 for 0 against 0 abstained, has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
