RESOLUTION NO. 3-19-79-B

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin developed a Title Search Project in 1977 and trained personnel to implement the basic identification of land Claims within the Oneida Reservation boundaries, and

WHEREAS, The Title Search Project will run out of funds on June 31, 1979, and

WHEREAS, The project will not have completed the research needed for the entire reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by virtue of it's trust responsibility to the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, the Bureau of Indian Affairs provide financial assistance in the amount of \$12,000.00 to continue the Oneida Title Search Project from July 1, 1979 to December 31, 1979, in order that we may achieve our goals of successfully identifying land claims within the exterior boundaries of the Oneida Indian Reservation.
