RESOLUTION 3-20-92-13

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treat Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated by authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin continues to support all efforts to encourage our youth in becoming the future leaders of the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin shall continue it's efforts to preserve and conserve the environment in which the Oneida People live.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe hereby submits an application to the Commission on National and Community Service to establish the Oneida Conservation Corps program under the American Conservation and Youth Service Corps Program.
