RESOLUTION 3/27/79-B

WHEREAS, an Oneida Reservation map, as drafted in 1872, reflects a shortage of approximately 3000 acres from maps currently in use that are in accordance with the 1838 United States survey; and,


WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is accountable to the Oneida Tribal membership for governmental functions of the membership and jurisdiction within established and defined boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs hereby account for any boundary errors and that ejectment and/or possession actions be instituted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs regarding lands that may be disputed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriate suits be brought by the Bureau of Indian Affairs on behalf of the Oneida Tribe for such damages as soon as feasible.
