RESOLUTION OF THE BUSINESS COMMITTEE OF THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN NO. 73-3-29

WHEREAS, the Business Committee of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin adopted Resolution No. 72-10-19 on October 19, 1972 which authorized the filing of an application for a loan of \$18,750, and

WHEREAS, the application was approved by the action of Assistant Secretary of the Interior, dated February 2, 1973, subject to certain conditions,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Business Committee of the Corporation hereby accepts the action of the Assistant Secretary of the Interior together with the conditions enumerated therein, provided the rate of interest and repayment terms are acceptable to the Business Committee.
