

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS the Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, has filed application with the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, Ashland, Wisconsin, for an additional road right-of-way for the purpose of widening an existing Town road running east and west on the Section line common to Sections 2 and 11, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, to a full width of 66 feet; and

WHEREAS the application for said right-of-way involves Oneida tribal land described as the West 7 acres of lot 11, Section 2, Town of Hobart, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, and the West 7 acres of the West 30 acres of the SW<sup>1/4</sup> SE<sup>1/4</sup> Section 2, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS the applicant, the Town of Hobart, has offered to pay a consideration of \$20 per acre for the acreage taken by the right-of-way, and this consideration is deemed to be fair and commensurate with values paid to other landowners in the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That consent is indicated herein to the granting of the right-of-way by the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, in accordance with the provisions of Title 25, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 161, and acceptance of the offered consideration.
