## ONEIDA BUSINESS COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

*75-4-7-H*

WHEREAS, the drafted Tribal policies and procedures need to be reviewed and approved by the Business Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED, that all people desiring changes made to the policies and procedures submit those changes to the Administrator in writing. The deadline for submission shall be April 14. One week subsequent to this, the Administrator shall present a summary of those changes and his recommendations to the Business Committee for their final review and approval. Subsequent to these recommendations the Administrator and Touche Ross & Co. will prepare the final Tribal Management policies and procedures manual.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that the Administrator shall be responsible for future policy and procedure changes and maintenance subject to final Business Committee review and approval.
