Resolution No. 4-7-93- A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin was notified by letter dated February 19, 1993 that the trust property of Edna Skenandore and Elizabeth Powless is for sale (see attachment), and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is aware that the trust restrictions will be removed if the property is not transferred to an enrolled Oneida Tribal member or the Oneida Tribe, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to make an offer to purchase.
