## RESOLUTION 75-4-16

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee on behalf of the Oneida Tribe Of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., is desirous of having its own Post Office, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has land available that is centrally located near the village of Oneida,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin apply to E.D.A. for 100% funding for a structure that will house the Oneida Post Office, a Youth Training Center, and an Arts and Craft Shop. This structure will be 100% funded by E.D.A.

### CERTIFICATION
