

RESOLUTION NO. 4-18-83-B

WHEREAS, The town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has filed with the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency Ashland Wisc, for additional road right-of-way for the purpose of widening Government Road, and

WHEREAS, The application for said right-of-way invades Oneida Tribal land location in Outagamie County, Wisconsin, discribed as:

Section 12, Township 23 N., R. 18 E., Outagamie Co., Wisc.

WHEREAS, The above named right-of-way applicants will pay for all consideration plus damages incurred as a result of the right-of-way including the acreage to be taken as determined to be fair by a Bureau of Indian Affairs appraiser, and

WHEREAS, The town of Oneida agrees to abide by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Shoreland Protection Ordinance, and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that consent is indicated herein to the granting of the desired right-of-way by the Superintendent Great Lakes Agency, in accordance with provisions of title 25, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 161.
