RESOLUTION # 4-20-94-A

PARTICIPATION IN AN INTER-TRIBAL ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS PROGRAM APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is authorized to enter into agreements which provide for tribal participation in activities designed to benefit the full tribal constituency, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has a need to participate in a program which would be coordinated through the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc., financed by an application submitted to the Administration for Native Americans, and include the following workplan elements:


1. A program which will promote and insure that long-term economic benefit is derived from the successful enterprises currently being operated by the Tribe; and
2. Implement joint tourism promotional activities between the Tribe and State of Wisconsin, and
3. Provide for a tribal government operations manual which will be designed to be the guide for the Tribe's decision making process, and

WHEREAS, tribal member and tribal official involvement in the ANA application process has been secured through a GLITC, Inc. Reorganization Task Force,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: this Tribal Council hereby agrees to participate in an Administration for Native Americans program application which will include activities as identified herein and designed to address tribal needs.
