RESOLUTION NO. 4-21-77

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. is the duly elected and recognized government of the Wisconsin Oneidas, and
- WHEREAS, it is the duty of the United States to represent all legal claims of the Wisconsin Oneidas, and
- WHEREAS, July 18, 1977 is the deadline for the filing of lawsuits by the United States on behalf of Indian governments and individual Indians for monetary claims arising before July 18, 1966, and
- "HEREAS, the Statute of Limitations, 28 U.S.C. § 2415, will expire on July 18, 1977 unless time is extended by Congress, and
- WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Oneidas have land possessory claims and damage claims in New York State and the State of Wisconsin which arose before July 18, 1966, and
- WHEREAS, many of our causes of action have not been properly identified, and
- UHEREAS, the Wisconsin Oneidas inability to prosecute the present claims will result in a considerable loss of such claims through no fault of our own, and
- WHEREAS, H.R. 5023 has been introduced in Congress and would amend the Statute of Limitations by extending the filing date for ten (10) years.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. fully support H.R. 5023 or any other legislation which would extend the Statute of Limitations so as not to jeopardize our legal claims, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wisconsin Oneidas ask representatives of the United States government to honor the Sacred Treaties and agreements into which the United States has entered with our Nation and to pass the proposed time extension in that regard.
