Resolution No. 4-21-93-F

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:

### HODKIEWICZ PROPERTY

A parcel of land located in Government Lot 21, Section 13; T23N, R18E, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, which is more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the SE corner of said Section 13; thence N90° 00'00"W, 402.34 feet along the South line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 13 to the point of beginning; thence continuing along said South line, N90° 00'00"W, 667.66 feet to the SW Corner of said Government Lot 21; thence N0° 50'37"E, 1313.61 feet along the West line of said Government Lot 21 to the NW Corner of said Government Lot 21; thence N89° 58'06"E, 1073.44 feet along the North line of said Government Lot 21 to the SE Corner of said Government Lot 21; thence S0° 59'35"W, 989.40 feet along the East line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 13; thence N89° 00'25"W, 402.34 feet; thence S0° 58'58"W, 331.77 feet (recorded as 331.94 feet) to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 29.29 acres of land more or less (27.85 act less road) and is subject to all easements and restrictions of record, reserving that part presently being used for road purposes. Said lands are intended to be the same as the lands described in J 10725 I 18.


WHEREAS, The above described parcel is requested in trust status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide a future site for economic development, agriculture, recreation, and residential purposes, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

### CERTIFICATION
