## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, INC., IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AND/OR FACILITATING BETTER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEARLY 1000 ONEIDA STUDENTS, AND

WHEREAS, IT IS THE INTENT OF THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN INC., TO OPTIMALLY ADMINISTER AND MANAGE ALL PROGRAMS DIRECTLY AFFECTING ITS MEMBERSHIP, AND

WHEREAS, THE SELF-DETERMINATION POLICY BECOMES MANIFEST WITH SUCH SELF-DIRECTION AND IMPLEMENTATION,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, INC. WILL CONTRACT WITH THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS FOR THE FOLLOWING CATEGORICAL MONIES:

(A) JOHNSON-O'MALLEY FOR F.Y. 1974

HIGHER EDUCATION GRANTS FOR F.Y. 1974

EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE FOR F.Y. 1974

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS FOR SUCH CONTRACTS WILL TAKE PLACE ON MAY 9, 1974, AT THE ONEIDA NATION MEMORIAL BUILDING AT 9 A.M.
