RESOLUTION # 4-22-86-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Trust/Enrollment Committee has been delegated the sole legal responsibility to administer the Oneida Trust Fund, and

WHEREAS, it has been ten years since the 1975 payment was made. An Act, Governing Unclaimed per capita shares, PL 87-283 provided that after a period of six years the unclaimed shares will be restored to tribal ownership, and


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the unclaimed shares will be disbursed to tribal beneficiaries in compliance with the Oneida Trust Agreement.

1. All of said sum to qualified spouse.
2. If no surviving qualified spouse, then to qualified children in equal shares.
3. If no qualified spouse or children, then to surviving qualified parents in equal shares.
4. If no qualified spouse, children or parents, then reversion back to the tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the unclaimed per capita shares be restored to the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
