- WHEREAS, the Farmers' Home Administration has made available funds for rural development, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Land Office has prepared the pre-application necessary to qualify for a farmers' Home Administration planning grant;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee hereby applies for the planning funds available under Farmers' Home Administration, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is hereby authorized to sign the necessary application forms to execute the grant.
