WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain, and promote self-sufficiency and self reliance by providing food for Oneida Tribal members and others in the community who cannot afford it, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe through the Oneida Food Distribution Program with the partnership of the Administration for Children and Families/Office of Community Services'/1998 Community Food and Nutrition Program with Oneida Community input, would continue the on-going operations of the distribution warehouse that is environmentally safe and sanitary for both workers, the storage, distribution of food products, and fresh produce, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family will be strengthened by promoting the values of our Oneida Identity by providing food.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin-Oneida Food Distribution Program authorizes and submits this grant application to the Administration for Children and Families/Office of Community Services/1998 Community Food and Nutrition Program for the purpose of securing lease monies and other expenses for the Oneida Food Distribution Warehouse Project.
