Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the Colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States was made possible.


Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-30-84-A

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has taken steps toward conservation and reforestation, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin have sought and been granted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to complete a Wisconsin Conservation Corps project, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin have held in account by the Bureau of Indian Affairs Timber account the amount of \$1,368.37, and
- WHEREAS, The said account is administered by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Minneapolis Area Office, Minneapolis, Minnesota,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, --- that the Bureau of Indian Affairs area office accomplish required accounting procedures to release the \$1,368.37 held in the Timber account for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, --- that the \$1,368.37 be used for the purpose of buying tree seedlings for reforestation efforts.
