RESOLUTION NO. 5-2-77

- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee the Constitutional authority to employ legal counsel by Article IV, 1, (b), and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin has legal claims to lands in New York and Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the legal claims may be lost if not prosecuted promptly due to the July 18,1977 Federal tatute of Limitations, 28 U.S.C. & 2415, and
- WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Business Committee to exercise the necessary enumerated powers of Article IV & 1 (b) to protect Tribal resources, and
- WHEREAS, the legal claims of the Wisconsin Oneidas are a Tribal resource which may be jeopardized if not prosecuted promptly, and
- WHEREAS, the Native American Rights Fund is a law firm dedicated to representing American Indian Tribal legal claims, and
- WHEREAS, the Native American Rights Fund has expressed willingness and capability of bringing all necessary legal action to protect the legal claims of the Wisconsin Oneidas,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin retain the Native American Rights Fund to protect and prosecute all legal claims subject to the Statute of Limitations.
