RESOLUTION # 5-4-90-G

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has established Social Service programs to promote the stability and security of Tribal families, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin has established the Oneida Group Home to work with adjudicated male youth, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that there is a need to expand services for delinquent and high-risk youth.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby make application for a Youth Aid Grant through the Brown County Youth Aids Fund.
