## RESOLUTION 5-08-96-D

**WHEREAS** The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

**WHEREAS** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

**WHEREAS** The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

**WHEREAS,** The Oneida Housing Authority requests Oneida Tribal Assistance and support of Project 10-16, a five (5) unit Low Rent Housing project with a force account T.D.C. budget of \$528,340.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin agrees to cover any costs in excess of the H.U.D. approved estimated construction costs of \$528,340;


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The Oneida Tribe has the resources to cover such excess costs of these rescinded OHA housing units;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This financial commitment is consistent with the Oneida Tribe's commitment to meet the housing needs of the Oneida people;

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED:** That this Oneida Tribal support is consistent with the Oneida Tribe's 1994 Comprehensive Housing Plan Resolution 11-23-94-G.
