Resolution Approving Renewal of Oneida Tribe of Indians/State of Wisconsin Gaming Compact

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of the Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of the Constitution of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated responsibility to enter into compacts by the General Tribal Council through adoption of the Oneida Comprehensive Gaming Ordinance, Article III, sec. E, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has negotiated a renewal to the Oneida Tribe of Indians/State of Wisconsin Gaming Compact of 1991,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves the renewal of the Oneida Tribe of Indians/State of Wisconsin Gaming Compact of 1991 as attached.
