RESOLUTION NO. 5-13-83-A

WHEREAS, currently, there are many failing, improperly operating or, otherwise, unacceptable private sewage disposal systems on Indian owned land on the Oneida Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, there are many unsafe, improperly installed or operating private wells serving Indian residences on the Oneida Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the presence of these failing or improperly operating sewage disposal systems and wells presents a serious potential health hazard to all who utilize them, and

WHEREAS, Public Law 86-121 recognizes the responsibility of the Federal Government to install and maintain sewage disposal and water systems for all Indian people, and

WHEREAS, Congress is not currently authorizing funding for proper maintenance, repair, or replacement of these failing sewage disposal and water systems, and

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service administers all funding authorized under P.L. 86-121, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee is concerned that all Oneida people have the opportunity to have properly functioning sewage disposal and water systems.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests Indian Health Service to pursue all possible avenues to obtain sanitation facilities construction money for use in replacing failed, or failing, sewage disposal and water supply systems for existing homes.
