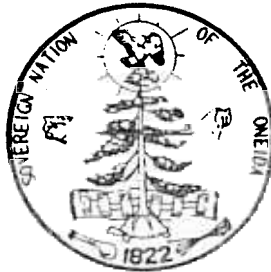

RESOLUTION 5-4-85-A

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe is supportive of Tribal members who enter higher education to improve their educational skills; and,
- WHEREAS, Bruce A. King is a Tribal member and is an employee of the Oneida Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, It would be mutually beneficial for the Oneida Tribe and Bruce A. King for Bruce A. King to attend Yale--School of Management Master Program in Public and Private Management; and,
- WHEREAS, The First American Finance Project is funding Native Americans to attend the Yale School of Management Program; and,
- WHEREAS, The FAFP requires that participants in the Tribal Commerce and Enterprise Program receive a commitment by a Tribe to hire the participant in the third year of the program.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe support Bruce A. King in his participation in the Tribal Commerce and Enterprise Program and agree to employ Bruce A. King in the third year of the Program.
