## TRIBAL RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Tribal organizations are entitled to contract with the Bureau to plan, conduct, and administer all or parts of any program which the Bureau is authorized to administer for the benefit of Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Inc., will provide encouragement and opportunities through the graduate scholarship grant program to deserving and capable Oneida students to continue their education and training beyond college in accordance with Bureau of Indian Affairs regulations, and;
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Inc., recognize the right of each individual to an equitable education, and;
- WHEREAS, Higher Education is deemed a continuing priority of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Inc., and;
- WHEREAS, There is an unmet need regarding graduate funding for Oneida students,
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., in order to provide adequate funds for its graduate students has the necessity to contract for additional funding from the American Indian Scholarship graduate program in order to effectively serve its graduate requests according to need,
- THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we receive the afore mentioned funding to start our program for fall start-up FY 1978-79 and that the Tribal Chairman, Mr. Purcell Powless be the official authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments there to.

## CERTIFICATION
