## RESOLUTION $\#_{6-3-93-A}$

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council at a meeting held on June 17, 1992 and approved expansion of the Oneida Tribe's gaming operations within the boundaries of the Oneida Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Enterprise Development Authority is chartered by the Oneida Business Committee pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 (h) of the Oneida Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Enterprise Development Authority is the developer for the Oneida Nation Casino and parking ramp within the boundaries of the Oneida Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe will be utilizing the Oneida Nation Casino and parking ramp to expand its gaming operations; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Enterprise Development Authority has secured a loan of approximately 5.0 million dollars from Miller & Schroeder Investments Corporation of Minneapolis to develop the Oneida Nation Casino and parking ramp; and
- WHEREAS, Miller & Schroeder Investments Corporation requires that the Oneida Tribe guaranty the payment of said Loan; and
- WHEREAS, the construction of a casino and parking ramp will expand the gaming operations within the boundaries of the Oneida Indian Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that in consideration of making said Loan, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin through it's duly elected officials, hereby agrees to execute and deliver the attached Guaranty to Miller & Schroeder Investments Corporation of Minneapolis and to perform all or any of the obligations and responsibilities designated in the Guaranty, if so required.

that the Oneida Business Committee is composed of 9 members of whom 5 members constitute a quorum. 7 members were present at a meeting duly called, noticed and held on the 3rd day of June, 1993; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by a vote of 6 members for; 0 members against, and 0 members not voting; and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
