

RESOLUTION NO. <u>06-03-98-E</u> Sandra Ninham Cancellation of Residential Lease

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Sandra Ninham, a tribal member, is holder of said lease no. $\underline{B-491}$ (68) more particularly described as follows: 630 Florist Drive, De Pere, WI 54115

South two (2) acres of the West seven (7) acres of the East thirty (30) acres of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, 4th P.M., Wisconsin, subject to valid rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, <u>Sandra Ninham</u>, holder of said leaseholders no longer wish to use said lease site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in <u>Regular</u> session assembled, hereby approve the above modification of lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease **CANCELLATION** documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Christine M. Doxtator, Land Management Director, or her designee, be authorized to execute said lease agreement on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
