RESOLUTION NO. 73-6-

- WHEREAS, education is one of the highest priorities of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee and Tribal members ^{are} concerned and involved in educational matters on the local, state and national levels, and
- WHEREAS, the President from the Key Biscayne, Florida White House on May 5, 1973 did announce the appointments of Boyce D. Timmons of Norman, Oklahoma and Will D. Antell of Stillwater, Minnesota, both sponsored by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, as members of the National Advisory Council on Indian Education, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin was not consulted on this sponsorship and did not have any knowledge of these recommendations prior to the announcement, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has a number of capable members who are knowledgeable and dedicated to education,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin requests immediate withdrawal of their announced sponsorship of Boyce D. Timmons, who is not known to the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and Will D. Antell,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the desire of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to sponsor one of it's own members immediately, if procedurally workable.

CERTIFICATION
