

RESOLUTION NO. 73-62

WHEREAS, The Town of Oneida, Wisconsin, has filed an application with the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, Ashland, Wisconsin, for a public road right-of-way across Oneida Tribal land, and

WHEREAS, said right-of-way is described as the west 1 rod of the east 2.5 rods of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T23N., R19E., Outagamie County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, said right-of-way will follow an existing road which has been in use for many years,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in session assembled that consent is indicated herein to the grant of the above right-of-way to the Town of Oneida, Wisconsin, and that monetary compensation in the amount of \$200.00 shall be acceptable provided that culverts are furnished for each driveway serving Indian homesites, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office Bureau of Indian Affairs, is hereby requested to approve said grant of right-of-way in accordance with provisions of Title 25, Code of Federal Regulations, part 161.
