WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council has designated the Education Board for the purposes of comprehensive planning for the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Education Board has designated a Community School as the priority area for expansion, and

WHEREAS, the Community School is based on the philosophy and experience gained in the Super Summer Session, held every summer for the last few years, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has technical assistance and funds for tribally operated Community Schools,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Bureau of Indian Affairs be requested to provide Mr. Paul Melchior to assist the Education Board in drafting a proposal for funds to operate the Oneida Community School.
