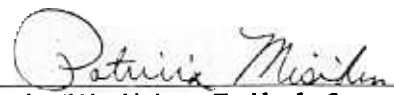
RESOLUTION NO. 6-11-79-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. needs Technical Assistance money for the development of the Oneida Industrial Park; and,
- WHEREAS, there is Technical Assistance money available through the Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs in Ashland, Wisconsin; and,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe would like to put a package together for the development of the Oneida Industrial Park; and,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is presently dealing with Bay Engineering Castings, Inc. for the purpose of expanding into our Industrial Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is hereby requesting Technical Assistance money in the amount of \$2,000 from the Great Lakes Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs in Ashland, Wisconsin, to put a package together for Bay Engineering Castings, Inc. of De Pere, Wisconsin, for the purpose of expanding into the Oneida Industrial Park and the Oneida Tribe would use this same package for further development of the Industrial Park.
