RESOLUTION # G-19-96-D

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Gary M. and Karen A. Adams, both tribal members are holders of said lease no. RL-2580 (94), more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land located within Claim 133, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 4, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of West Ridge Road and Old Seymour Road; thence N.64 degrees 50 feet W., a distance of 200 feet; thence S.34 degrees W., a distance of 33 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence continuing S34 degrees W., a distance of 214.50 feet; thence N.64 degrees 50 feet W., a distance of 100 feet; thence N34 degrees E., a distance of 214.50 feet; thence S.64 degrees 50 feet E., a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning, containing .50 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, Gary M. And Karen A. Adams, holders of said leaseholders no longer wish to use said lease site.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in Regular session assembled, hereby approve the above modification of lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease CANCELLATION documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
