RESOLUTION 6-28-79-A

WHEREAS, a coordinated and current economic development program is essential for the maintenance and improvement of the quality of life on the Oneida Reservation of Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Planning Office was instructed to update the Tribal Economic Development Plan for 1977-79 and the 1978-80 Update to that plan.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Planning Office has completed its work and has recommended revised goals and objectives to the Oneida Business Committee for its approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves the 1979-1981 Overall Economic Development Plan Update for the Oneida Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Planning Office be and they are hereby authorized to release and distribute the adopted 1979-1981 OEDP Update and pursue development and funding sources.
