the resolution of 20, 1949 has been rescinded

IN AS much as the business transacted is for and on behalf of the tribal membership, the General Tribal Council should have a full and equal voice, and

WHEREAS it is often difficult to obtain a quorum to transact business,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the powers under Article IV-A., B., C., D., E., and F. be delegated to the Executive Committee in accordance with 1. and 2. of Article IV in the Constitution and bylaws with the exception that no more than \$1200.00 be spent for one express purpose without the direct consent of the General Tribal Council, also that the word review as used in Article III be defined to mean change or amend whichever is deemed necessary by the General Tribal Council.
