WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin have been designated a prime sponsor for the Title 11 Manpower Programs from the Department of Labor,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe will also be involved in the Title 1 and Title 111 programs from D.O.L.,

WHEREAS, these programs present a new approach to cope with the high unemployment and underemployment of Indian people,

WHEREAS, an Indian Desk is to be set up on D.O.L. to help Indian people with their programs,

WHEREAS, Alexander Mc Nabb now working in D.O.L. has an excellent track record of assisting Indian people both in the B.I.A and the Department of Interior,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee does hereby indorse Alexander Mc Nabb for Director of Indian Programs for CETA
