
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has established various Divisions, Areas and Departments to provide economic, educational, health, social services, and management of day to day business for the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Social Services is charged with providing all social services and is the lead agency offering such service, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the Oneida Nation Social Services is authorized to make application to the United States Department of Human Services, Administration and Youth, Chicago Regional Office for the Native American, Family Preservation Oneida allocation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The Oneida Tribe of Indians will support the project and will make every effort possible to encourage the completion of The Oneida Family Preservation Plan on file with the Administration of Children and Youth, Chicago Regional Office.
